



JUNIOR SIGN ON 2021

Welcome to the Rabbitohs South Darwin Rugby Union Club (SDRU)!

We welcome boys and girls to train and play with SDRU to develop life-long skills including fitness, teamwork, good sportsmanship and a sense of fair play.

The 2021 rugby union season runs from October 2021 to March 2022. There are 15 rounds as part of the competition, and games are played mainly on Friday nights after 6pm.

Registering to play with SDRU is easy.

STEP 1: Register and pay through Rugby Xplorer (step-by-step instructions are provided in a separate document)

If applicable, email a copy of your Northern Territory (NT) Government Sports voucher to the Junior Co-ordinator at juniors@southdarwin.com.au – upon verification you will then be emailed a discount code to use in Rugby Xplorer to deduct the club fees from your final registration fees.

STEP 2: We will send you a welcome letter with details of training, games, uniform collection and contact details. If you haven't heard back from us, you are welcome to email us at any time at rugby@southdarwin.com.au

Junior Registrations

Uniforms

All junior players will receive a training singlet, playing shorts and socks as part of their registration. This order can be placed when registering your child through Rugby Xplorer. If you would like to order other club merchandise, please visit our online shop at [Team App](#).

The training singlet, playing shorts and socks will be available for collection on Tuesdays and Thursdays 5.30pm - 6.30pm from the Warren Park Rugby Clubhouse, Alaba Rd, Marrara. We will contact you when these are ready to collect (please note items may not be available until the first match of the season).



Playing jerseys for game nights will be part of the team kit managed by the coach. A roster will be provided within the first weeks of the season to each family to wash the jerseys – this will be arranged by the team manager.

Registration Costs

Registration fees include Australian Rugby Union and NT Rugby Union participation fees and SDRU club fee for players aged 7 and over.

NT Government \$100 Sport vouchers are accepted by SDRU for club fees. Please email the NT sport voucher to juniors@southdarwin.com.au to gain a club discount code to use as part of your registration through Rugby Xplorer.

U6s (\$40 total)

\$40 Australian Rugby Union/NT Rugby Union participation fee – this covers insurance and competition fees for the season.

No club fees will need to be paid for U6s – players will receive a training singlet, shorts and socks.

Age 7 (\$180 total)

\$80 Australian Rugby Union/NT Rugby Union participation fee – this covers insurance and competition fees for the season.

\$100 SDRU club fee – this covers training singlet, shorts, socks, team kit, and club events including junior presentation.

Age 8-12 (\$187 total)

\$87 Australian Rugby Union/NT Rugby Union participation fee – this covers insurance and competition fees for the season.

\$100 club fee – this covers training singlet, shorts, socks, team kit, and club events including junior presentation.

Age 13-18 (\$190 total)

\$90 Australian Rugby Union/NT Rugby Union participation fee – this covers insurance and competition fees for the season.

\$100 club fee – this covers training singlet, shorts, socks, team kit, and club events including junior presentation.
